- 1. Reveille X**

Reveille X is accompanied by her handler Grayson Poage, Class of 2025. She is the official mascot of Texas A&M University and has reigned as the First Lady of Aggieland since 1931. As the highest-ranking member of the Corps of Cadets, Miss Rev wears five silver diamonds on her blanket. A BIG "Thank You" to Appel Ford for donating the vehicle for Reveille X!
- 2. Ross Volunteers**

The Ross Volunteer Company is the oldest honor guard and drill team of its kind in the state of Texas. The honor guard was formed in 1887 and was originally named the Scott Volunteers. In 1898, the unit was renamed in honor of Lawrence Sullivan Ross, former governor of the state of Texas and President of the Agricultural and Mechanical College of Texas. The company, which serves as the official Honor Guard of the Governor of Texas, is composed of junior and senior cadets. The cadets wear very distinctive white uniform with yellow trim, while officers wear a solid red sash around the waist of their uniforms. The Ross Volunteers assist with numerous events across our city, state and nation each year. The company serves as the Honor Guard of King Rex, the King of Mardi Gras, in New Orleans and has marched in the King Rex Parade since 1947.
- 3. Fightin' Texas Aggie Band**

The Fightin' Texas Aggie Band is nationally known for its precision military marching formations on the football gridiron and it's the largest military marching band in the nation. This 340-member, Corps of Cadets unit is the official marching band of Texas A&M University. Performing at all home football games and several away games, this organization is one of the most traveled collegiate marching bands in the nation. The Aggie Band operates under strict military guidelines as an integral part of the Corps of Cadets. The Aggie Band was presented the Sudler Trophy from the John Philip Sousa Foundation in 2001 in recognition of the long tradition of excellence established by the organization. The Aggie Band is directed Dr. Timothy Rhea, Dr. Russell Tipton, and Dr. Lance Sample.
- 4. Parsons Mounted Cavalry**

Ladies and Gentlemen, Parsons Mounted Cavalry is participating in today's parade. This horse unit consists of cavalry, artillery, and quartermaster elements. Military training at A&M included mounted drill until 1943, when the Army disbanded its horse operations. The Class of 74 revived the Cavalry tradition at A&M in 1974. The Corps named the unit after then Commandant of the Corps of Cadets, Colonel Thomas R. Parsons. The Corps uses military horse training to teach cadets self-discipline, confidence, leadership, and decision-making. Learning to manage animals much larger than themselves with a mind of its own in challenging conditions develops many of the skills necessary for modern business and military leaders. Today's Unit consists of 65 horses and 7 mules, most of which were donated and are now owned by the Unit. Beyond training and technical assistance, the Agency sponsors Texas A&M Task Force 1 (TX-TF1) and Texas A&M Public Works Response Team (TX-PWRT).

Texas A&M Task Force 1 (TX-TF1) is a search and rescue team that provides emergency response personnel and resources during disasters. Texas A&M Public Works Response Team (TX-PWRT) includes public works professionals and equipment that restore public works such as water, gas and electricity after a disaster. Both response teams are supported by TEEX.
